RECIPIENTS OF OAKLAND-ALAMEDA COUNTY COLISEUM FOUNDATION ANN AND JON REYNOLDS SCHOLARSHIPS NAMED

Ronald C. Nahas, President of the Board of Directors of the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Foundation, announced the recipients of the Ann and Jon Reynolds scholarships. The scholarships, named for former Coliseum Board Member/current Coliseum Foundation Board Member Jon Reynolds and his wife Ann, are for \$3,000 a year to a maximum of \$12,000 within a five-year period. They are awarded to graduating seniors from Alameda County high schools. Criteria include a 3.0 grade point average, two years of community service and a need for financial aid. Each awardee must stay in good academic standing and progress towards obtaining a baccalaureate degree to continue to receive the award.

CARA HE graduated from Skyline High School. UC Berkeley, UCLA, UC Davis and the University of Southern California offered her admission. She will attend UC Berkeley with a proposed major of psychology. Her grade point average was 4.13. Her community activities included the Rotary Interact Club. She was a peer educator in the HEART program. She noted her experiences there have had an impact on her goal of being "an aspiring social worker".

EDWARD NGUYEN graduated from Mission San Jose High School with a 3.3 grade point average. He has been accepted for admission at Santa Clara University, UC Irvine, UCSB and UC Santa Cruz. He will attend Santa Clara University with a proposed major of Computer Science and Engineering. He has served as the president of the City of Fremont Youth Advisory Commission, lead attorney of the McCallum Youth Court and a volunteer at My New Red Shoes providing service at a homeless shelter.

The Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Foundation was established to honor Coliseum President Emeritus Robert T. Nahas and to oversee charitable programs associated with the Coliseum. The Foundation also awards the George P. Scotlan and Robert T. Nahas scholarships.
